Disaster assistance available for Louisiana small businesses

Small, nonfarm businesses in all 64 Louisiana parishes are eligible to apply for low-interest disaster loans from the U. S. Small Business Administration (SBA). These loans offset economic losses because of reduced revenues caused by the combined effects of severe storms, tornadoes, severe spring flooding, Tropical Storm Lee, widespread drought and excessive heat that occurred in the entire state of Louisiana beginning January 1, 2011.
